Sometimes it is required to receive worker training before working with a pallet haul or heavy equipment. It is very important to determine beforehand what kind of duties may be necessary before purchasing a new pallet jack. In a facility with small aisles or constricted spaces, deciding on a pallet haul that is capable of maneuvering down the aisles may be the best decision. If the warehouse already has an overhead lift currently installed, then perhaps, an attachment for the existing jack may be the best alternative.
